## ORDINANCE No. 184471

\*Amend Intergovernmental Agreement with Oregon Department of Transportation for equipment and services and to extend termination date (Ordinance; amend Contract No. 30001817)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. That authority has been granted in ORS 190.110, 366.572, 366.576 to the Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) to enter into cooperative agreements with the counties, cities, and units of local government for the performance of work on certain types of maintenance or improvement projects with the allocation of costs on terms and conditions mutually agreeable to the contracting partners.
- 2. Per Ordinance No. 181990, passed by City Council on July, 2, 2008, an agreement was approved allowing for equipment sharing and services as a complement to the existing PMAT Co-operative Intergovernmental Agreement to include ODOT as a regional partner.
- 3. Ordinance No. 181990 also allowed that the Agreement could be modified by mutual consent of all parties and upon execution of amendments to the agreement stating said modifications.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. That the Commissioner-in-Charge is authorized to approve and execute Amendment 1 to Contract No. 30001817 with Oregon Department of Transportation as outlined in a form substantially in accordance with the attached Amendment document approved as to form by the City Attorney.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because the current agreement is set to expire on March 13, 2011; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
