ORDINANCE No. 184474

* Accept an Oregon Military Department, Office of Emergency Management, Department of Homeland Security, FY 2010 Urban Areas Security Initiative Grant to plan for terrorism events through planning, training and equipping First Responders. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Department of Homeland Security is providing financial assistance to selected urban areas through the FY 2010 Urban Areas Security Initiative (UASI). The City of Portland, in cooperation with regional partners (TriMet, Port of Portland, Multnomah, Clackamas, Washington and Columbia Counties of Oregon and Clark County, Washington) applied for financial assistance to address the unique equipment, training, planning, exercise and operational needs of large urban areas.
- 2. The Department of Homeland Security has designated Portland, Oregon as the core urban area in the State of Oregon. The City of Portland will be eligible for a portion of the \$6,874,736 available to our regional metropolitan area.
- 3. Funds provided under the UASI Grant Program will be granted directly to the States with no less than 80% of the total award going to selected urban areas.
- 4. Funds will be used and dedicated for equipment, training, planning and exercises.
- 5. The Portland urban Area has completed a regional strategy to guide the use of federal homeland security grant funds.
- 6. The City of Portland Office of Emergency Management will administer the Grant for the region.
- 7. There is no financial match requirement for this Grant.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor and Portland Office of Emergency Management are authorized to accept the FY 2010 Urban Areas Security Initiative grant from the Oregon Military Department, Office of Emergency Management (OEM).
- b. The FY 2010/2011 budget is hereby amended as follows:

GRANTS FUND

Fund 217001 Business Area – EM00 Bureau Program Expenses- \$0

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists in that any delay in receipt for this grant will result in losing the opportunity for funding these activities; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
