ORDINANCE No. 184496

Authorize a contract with Kennedy/Jenks Consultants, Inc. for design service for the Underground Injection Control Project No. E10175 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

- Section 1. The Council finds:
 - 1. The City uses Underground Injection Control (UIC) facilities (sumps) to control street storm runoff.
 - 2. The City identified 219 UICs as noncompliant with the Water Pollution Control Facility (WPCF) permit issued by DEQ in 2005.
 - 3. The City made a comprehensive Corrective Action Plan and submitted it to the DEQ in 2006.
 - 4. WPCF permit classifies noncompliant UICs into four categories. This project is category 3 and is the 4th of 5 packages to retrofit existing UIC's to meet DEQ standards.
 - 5. An RFP was issued in accordance with City Code 5.58 to solicit professional services for design services for the UIC Category 3, Package 4 project (RFP # BES111). Kennedy/Jenks Consultants Inc. was selected as the highest scoring proposer.
 - 6. M/W/ESB participation on this is 6%.
 - 7. The established cost is \$262,106. Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY 2010 2011 Budget, Bureau of Environmental Services, E10175.D14

NOW, THEREFORE, the council directs:

- a. The Commissioner of Public Affairs is authorized to execute a contract with Kennedy/Jenks, Inc., in a form substantially in accordance with the contract attached as Exhibit A, for the purpose described in Section 1.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.
