**ORDINANCE No. 184515**

\*Authorize grant agreement with Janus Youth Programs in the amount of \$50,000 to support the launch of the Village Market Project at New Columbia (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council Finds:

1. In coordination with Janus Youth Programs and the Housing Authority of Portland, the City will support Janus Youth Program's Village Market Project.
2. The Village Market Project will provide access to healthy affordable food for the residents of New Columbia and the Portsmouth Neighborhood. The project will bring the opportunity for community building, civic engagement, employment, health and hope to the nearly 3,000 people living in New Columbia.
3. The Village Market Project will also serve as a model for the region and will help build the growing case for healthy retail access in our most vulnerable neighborhoods. It provides an example for addressing "food deserts" and for promoting the "twenty minute neighborhood" concept emerging from the Portland Plan.
3. City support of the market will cover start up expenses to launch the healthy foods grocery store and support the first few months of operations.
4. Janus Youth Programs will administer funding for the Village Market Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Commissioner-in-charge and Auditor are hereby authorized to enter into a grant agreement with Janus Youth Programs with the agreement attached as Exhibit A.
- b. The mayor and City Auditor are hereby authorized to pay for said contract from the General Fund.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because delay in funding would interrupt the Janus Youth Program's ability to launch the Village Market; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by Council.


