ORDINANCE No. 184529

*Authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement and accept a grant in the amount of \$15,000 from the Portland Development Commission for construction of Safe Routes to School project improvements on SE 104th Ave from SE Harold to SE Holgate. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Bureau of Transportation's Safe Routes to School program enhances opportunities for children to walk or ride bicycles from home to school, promotes a healthier lifestyle through walking and bicycling to school, and focuses on safety, traffic reduction, and air quality improvement around schools.
- 2. The vision for the Bureau of Transportation calls for a balanced, multi-modal transportation system where residents have a broad range of safe and convenient transportation options such as walking, bicycling, riding transit.
- 3. The Portland Development Commission recognizes the need for such enhancements and has agreed to fund traffic calming improvements on SE 104th Avenue as a part of the Lent Elementary Safe Routes to School project.
- 4. The Portland Bureau of Transportation is also constructing a number of other improvements as a part of the Lent Elementary Safe Routes to School project that include improved crossings, traffic calming, sidewalk infill, and ADA compliant curb ramps.
- 5. The Safe Routes to School program has conducted robust outreach during the development of the safety plan and the bureau intends to continue outreach during the design and construction phase.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Director of the Bureau of Transportation is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland a grant from the Portland Development Commission for the Lent Elementary Safe Routes to School project in the amount of \$15,000 and to execute an Intergovernmental Agreement in substantially the form of the attached exhibit for this purpose.
- b. The FY 2010/2011 budget is hereby amended as follows

<u>GRANTS FUND</u> Fund 217007 Business Area –TR00 Bureau Program Expenses - \$15,000 c. The OMF Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.

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d. The Bureau of Transportation is directed to continue outreach to neighborhoods and the community during design and construction of Safe Routes to School projects following the programmatic Council approved process for neighborhood greenways.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would unnecessarily delay the City's ability to perform the activities authorized by the grant; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
