*Accept a grant in the amount of \$35,000 from Oregon Emergency Management for the FY 2010 State Homeland Security Grant. (Ordinance)

2) Purpose of the Proposed Legislation:

Oregon Emergency Management has notified the City of Portland that it will award a grant for the FY 2010 SHSP to the Portland Office of Emergency Management in the amount of \$35,000.

The State Homeland Security Grant supports the implementation of state and local homeland security strategies to address the identified planning, organization, equipment, training, and exercise needs for acts of terrorism and other catastrophic events.



7. BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS

The Department of Homeland Security, Preparedness Directorate, Office of Grants and Training are providing financial assistance to the City of Portland through the FY 2010 State Homeland Security Grant Program. The grant provides funds to build local capabilities to prevent, protect against, respond to and recover from terrorist attacks and other emergencies.

The State of Oregon applied for and received funds under the FY 2010 State Homeland Security Grant Program (SHSP); the City of Portland will receive \$35,000.00 of those funds. SHSP supports the implementation of state and local homeland security strategies to address the identified planning, organization, equipment, training, and exercise needs for acts of terrorism and other catastrophic events.
