## 184536 ORDINANCE No.

\* Authorize the Director of the Bureau of Environmental Services to enter into agreements to evaluate and implement natural resource restoration projects related to the Portland Harbor Superfund Site. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

## Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Bureau of Environmental Services has been designated the lead agency for the City for the Portland Harbor Superfund Site to manage and coordinate the City's participation in the investigation, cleanup and restoration of the Site.
- 2. As part of the Superfund process, the City will be required to implement natural resource restoration projects; funds are available in the Environmental Remediation Fund, No. 608000. and appropriation will be requested in the Spring BMP.

## NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Director of the Bureau of Environmental Services is authorized to enter into agreements to evaluate and implement natural resource restoration projects related to potential liability for natural resource damages in the Portland Harbor.
- b. The Director of the Bureau of Environmental Services or his designee and the City Attorney's Office are authorized to negotiate agreements to evaluate and implement such natural resource restoration projects.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because the City could otherwise miss opportunities for agreements to implement early restoration projects that would be beneficial to the City and the environment; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
