\* Authorize a grant providing Worksystems, Inc. \$195,000 to implement the SummerWorks youth employment program within City Bureaus. (Ordinance)

# 2) Purpose of the Proposed Legislation:

The City of Portland and Worksystems, Inc. agree to implement the SummerWorks youth employment program within City Bureaus during Summer 2011. The program will provide work-readiness training, a 180-hour paid work experience, and ongoing support through a job coach for up to 100 youth working at the City of Portland.

This legislation does not impact revenues.

This legislation will result in expenditure not to exceed \$195,000 in order to award Worksystems, Inc. its grant. Individual internships cost \$1,950 and participating bureaus are to pay half of the internship costs (\$975 per internship) from within their existing bureau budgets. No additional funds will be requested by bureaus in support of this program. The Mayor's Office will match the costs the bureaus are paying. The Mayor's Office matching funds are available in the Mayor's Office Education Program budget and were appropriated in the FY 2010-11 Adopted Budget.
