

# ORDINANCE No. 184561

Authorize a contract and provide for payment for the construction of the Burlingame Trunk Sewer Improvement Project No. E09052 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. Improvements to the Burlingame Trunk Sewer are necessary to provided additional downstream capacity for the expanded Fanno Pump Station to service the Fanno Basin.
2. Environmental Services has prepared plans and specifications for enlarging and lining the existing sewer.
3. Environmental Services required the furnishing of materials and labor for this project.
4. The established cost is \$ 5,630,000. The level of confidence in this estimate is high. Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY 2010-2011 Budget, Bureau of Environmental Services, WBS Element E09052.

NOW, THEREFORE, the council directs:

- a. The Commissioner of Public Affairs is authorized to execute a contract with the lowest responsible bidder for the purpose described in Section 1.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.
