

ORDINANCE No. 184562

Amend contract with West Yost Associates for additional work and compensation for the Outfall 27 / Sellwood Combined Sewer Overflow Pump Station Project No. E08467 (Ordinance; amend Contract No. 37818)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Bureau of Environmental Services (BES) has need of continuing professional engineering services provided by West Yost Associates to provide additional engineering support services during the construction of the Outfall 27 / Sellwood CSO Pump Station Project, BES Project No. E08467.
2. West Yost Associates is continuing to provide professional engineering services under Contract No. 37818, effective February 29, 2008 with an expiration date of February 28, 2013.
3. Engineering support is imperative to the successful and timely completion of this project which is required to meet the ASFO requirements.
4. The estimated cost of this contract amendment is \$287,484. Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY 2010 Budget, Bureau of Environmental Services, Project No. E08467. The total of the professional engineering services Contract 37818 will be \$2,564,768.

NOW, THEREFORE, the council directs:

- a. The Commissioner of Public Affairs is authorized to execute Amendment 3 to contract 37818 with West Yost Associates for the purpose described in Section 1.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.


