

ORDINANCE No. 184578

*Amend Intergovernmental Agreement with Multnomah County for diesel emission reductions and provide payment of \$6,000 for labor costs associated with grant activities. (Ordinance; amend Contract No. 30001037)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds that:

1. In December of 2009, the City of Portland entered into an Intergovernmental Agreement with Multnomah County (Ordinance No. 183402; Contract No. 30001037) for clean diesel fleet retrofits paid for by a grant from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency.
2. Installing fuel operated coolant heaters on City of Portland and Multnomah County fleet vehicles is a diesel emission reduction strategy outlined in the grant work plan.
3. Multnomah County's Fleet Services staff performed the labor to install the heaters on several pieces of Multnomah County's fleet vehicles and equipment.
4. The City of Portland seeks to use grant funds to make up to \$6,000 in direct payments to Multnomah County to cover the full costs of installing the heaters.


NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. They Mayor and the Auditor are hereby authorized to amend the Intergovernmental Agreement with Multnomah County in a form substantially in accordance with the amendment attached as Exhibit A to pay Multnomah County for the heater installation costs.
- b. The Mayor and the Auditor hereby are authorized to pay for said contract from the FY 2010-11 Budget, Cost Object SD00420006.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because the City of Portland's grant agreement with the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency expires on June 30, 2011; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
