## ORDINANCE No. 184585

Designate four Multnomah County tax foreclosed properties deeded to the City as public right-of-way (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

## Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Multnomah County transferred title to four tax foreclosed properties to the City for public purposes by Document No. 2010-159805, recorded December 10, 2010 (RWA File # 6254-2010).
- 2. The Portland Bureau of Transportation accepted the gratis transfer of the four properties with the intent that they become City right-of-way.
- 3. The four parcels abut existing right-of-way and should now be designated as public right-of-way for future improvements and eliminate potential taxes.
- 4. Pursuant to City Code, Title 29.20.010 and Title 17.42.010, maintenance of improved or unimproved rights-of-way is the responsibility of the abutting property owner at the property owner's expense except at the discretion of the City as provided for therein.
- 5. If the parcels are not used for public purposes, the title for that parcel will revert to the County.

## NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. That the four parcels of land described on Exhibit 1 attached hereto, are hereby designated as public right-of-way.
- b. That the Auditor shall return a certified copy of this Ordinance to the Right-of-Way Acquisition Section, Bureau of Transportation, for recording in the Multnomah County Deed Records; Right-of-Way Acquisition shall return the recorded Ordinance to the Auditor and retain a copy for its records.
