

ORDINANCE NO. 184589

*Accept a \$35,000 grant award from Partners for a Hunger Free Oregon to increase the number of free lunches served in selected City parks (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. Portland Parks & Recreation (PP&R) has long been an advocate for summer lunch programs.
2. Beginning in 1906, the first summer playgrounds program was offered and PP&R has become a major partner in the effort to provide free summer lunches to children throughout the city.
3. In 2009, 63,395 lunches were served, and in 2010, in spite of a 43% (\$75,000) decrease in funding, the number of lunches served grew to 78,633. Last year, PP&R received two grants that allowed the bureau to both maintain and grow the program.
4. The economic conditions that led the Portland City Council to reduce funding for this important program continue into 2011. It is projected that the ability to serve 26,000 lunches is at risk.


NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept a grant in the amount of \$35,000 from the Partners for a Hunger Free Oregon to increase the number of free lunches served to children in need during the summer months in selected city parks.
- b. The OMF Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists in order to receive the grant funds prior to the start of the summer playground program; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
