ORDINANCE No. 184615

*Amend a grant from the Federal Emergency Management Agency Hazard Mitigation Grant Program in the amount of \$26,667 to conduct a Community Risk Reduction Strategy to complement the 2010 Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan/Risk Reduction Strategy (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds

- 1. Portland Office of Emergency Management (POEM) applied to the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) for a grant in the amount of \$26,667 to conduct a Community Risk Reduction Strategy to complement the 2010 Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan/Risk Reduction Strategy;
- 2. The 2010 Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan (NHMP) AKA Portland's Natural Hazard Risk Reduction Strategy has been approved by the Oregon Office of Emergency Management and the FEMA Region X regional office;
- 2. Financial assistance of 75% of project cost is available for qualifying projects through the FEMA Hazard Mitigation Grant program;
- 3. The involvement of the public in reducing disaster impacts is integral to the city becoming a safer, resilient and livable city;
- 4. The proposed project is a necessary step in accomplishing numerous action items in Portland's Natural Hazard Risk Reduction Strategy;
- 5. There is a 25% match to the grant of \$6,667 which will be met through contributed equivalent hours from existing City staff and volunteers over the life of the project.
- 6. The proposed \$26,667 will be part of POEM's contribution to a Citywide public involvement project promoting strategies for a safer city.
- 7. Portland Office of Emergency Management will administer the grant.

NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland a grant from FEMA for \$26,667 to update the Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan update.
- b. The FY 2010/2011 budget is hereby amended as follows:

GRANTS FUND

Fund 217001

Business Area -EM00

Bureau Program Expenses – 511400 - \$3,250

- c. The Office of Management & Finance Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.
- d. The Director of the Portland Office of Emergency Management is authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland any subsequent modifications by FEMA for Hazard Mitigation Grant Program award number DR-1733-OR, provided such modifications do not increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk. Any modifications that increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk must be authorized by the Portland City Council.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists so as to maximize the grant award period of performance. Therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
