

APPENDIX B: ONE NIGHT SHELTER COUNT PARTICIPATION

The One Night Shelter Count is conducted by organizations across Multnomah County that provide emergency shelter, motel vouchers, transitional housing, rent/ mortgage assistance, or permanent supportive housing.
