ORDINANCE NO. 184640

* Amend subrecipient contract with Housing Authority of Portland to extend contract period to June 30, 2012, and add \$93,853 to provide additional short-term rent assistance for homelessness prevention and rapid rehousing. (Ordinance; amend Contract No. 32000138)

The City of Portland ordains:

SECTION 1. The Council finds that:

1. The City of Portland passed Ordinance No. 183296 authorizing Subrecipient Contract No. 32000138 with the Housing Authority of Portland (HAP) to operate the Short-Term Rent Assistance (STRA) program, which provides homelessness prevention and rapid rehousing activities through a network of 19 community based agencies.
2. The City of Portland passed Ordinances 183608, 184025, and 184336 authorizing amendment of Subrecipient Contract No. 32000138 to extend the contract duration and funding to provide additional homelessness prevention and rapid rehousing activities.
3. The effective date and duration of this contract will be extended to June 30, 2012.
4. Funding in the amount of \$93,853 in Federal Homelessness Prevention and Rapid Rehousing Program (HPRP) funds from the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) will be added to this contract through amendment for a total three-year not to exceed amount of \$4,989,518 through the allocation of existing appropriations in PHB's FY 2010-11 Ending Homelessness Initiative budget.
5. The additional funds will be used to provide homelessness prevention and rapid rehousing activities through June 30, 2012.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Bureau Director and the City Auditor are hereby authorized to amend Subrecipient Contract No. 32000138 with HAP in accordance with the amendment attached as Exhibit A.
- b. The Mayor and City Auditor are hereby authorized to make payment chargeable to the FY 2011-12 budget when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.




