ORDINANCE No. 184642

*Amend Lease Agreement with Macadam Bay Homeowners Association to reduce the size of the leased premises (Ordinance; amend Contract No. 21004)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- The City of Portland (City) through its Bureau of Parks & Recreation (Parks) owns 1. property between the Willamette River and Macadam Avenue that includes Butterfly Park.
- 2. Pursuant to Ordinance No. 154833 and a Lease Agreement (Contract No 21004), dated November 8, 1983, Macadam Bay Homeowners Association (Macadam Bay), or its predecessors, has leased from the City 1.85 acres of real property consisting of 1S1E22AC 4800 (TL 4800) and 1S1E22DB 100, in addition to subleasing from the City 4.46 acres of state waterway (collectively, Leased Premises), which it uses as a residential moorage and parking area.
- In the 1990's TL 4800 was developed into Butterfly Park by Parks and this property 3. continues to be managed by Parks.
- 4. Although Macadam Bay originally planned to use TL 4800 as part of its moorage, it does not make any use of this parcel and would like it removed from the Leased Premises so that it will no longer have any responsibility or liability for it.
- This amendment will remove TL 4800 from the Leasehold. 5.

NOW, THEREFORE, The Council Directs:

The Director of Portland Parks & Recreation is authorized to execute a Lease a. Amendment in a form substantially similar to the attached and as approved as to form by the City Attorney.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists in order to prevent Macadam Bay from further exposure to liabilities associated with TL 4800; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
