## ORDINANCE No. 184648

\* Amend City Code Chapter relating to distribution of prostitution forfeiture funds (Ordinance; amend Code Chapter 14B.50)

The City of Portland Ordains:

## Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. On October 27, 2010, Council passed Ordinance no. 184197 dedicating funds for shelter and services for victims of human trafficking.
- 2. On October 27, 2010, Council was made aware that certain technical changes would need to be made in order to accord with state law, and to allow the Portland Police Bureau to recoup costs from such forfeiture proceedings. Those changes are embodied in the attached Exhibit A.

## NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. City Code Chapter 14B.50 Forfeiture is amended, as provided in Exhibit A.

Section 2. The Council declares an emergency exists because a delay in proceeding with this ordinance will unnecessarily deprive victims of human trafficking they require. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
