

## ORDINANCE No. 184662

\*Amend contract with the Alliance for Community Traffic Safety for provision of child safety seat assembly services through June 30, 2012 and increase by \$8,000. (Ordinance, amend Contract No. 30000066)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The City's Safe Routes to School program works with schools, neighborhoods, and community organizations to encourage students and families to get to and from school in ways that reduce traffic, increase safety, build strong bodies and clear minds, and provide a cleaner environment.
2. The Alliance for Community Traffic Safety (ACTS) was selected through a competitive bid process to provide child safety seat assembly services to Pre-K through 1st grade students at 25 Portland elementary schools in Portland.
3. The City is interested in having ACTS continue to provide child safety seat assembly services to Pre-K-1st grade students in 25 elementary schools in Portland through June 20, 2012.
4. The Bureau's level of confidence in the cost estimates for this project is high, and funds are included in Transportation's FY 11/12.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. That the Commissioner-in-Charge and Auditor are authorized to amend Contract No. 30000066 with the Alliance for Community Traffic Safety, extending it through June 30, 2012 and adding \$8,000 in a form substantially in accordance with the amendment attached to the original of this ordinance and, by reference, made a part hereof.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because the existing contract is set to expire on June 30, 2011 and the parties wish to continue providing child safety seat assembly services without a gap in services; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.


