ORDINANCE No. 380184683

*Authorize the Bureau of Transportation to execute a Right of Entry Agreement with the United States Postal Service needed for construction activities related to the Portland Streetcar Loop Project (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. As part of the Portland Streetcar Loop Project (Loop Project), it is necessary to install poles on the Lovejoy Ramp (Ramp) to support the overhead wire system that powers the streetcar.
2. Part of this installation includes brackets attached to the south side of the Ramp. In order for this to occur, it is necessary to access the Ramp from the United States Postal Service (USPS) parking lot located on the southeast corner of NW 9th Avenue and NW Lovejoy Street.
3. The USPS has provided a Right of Entry Agreement (Agreement) that allows the work to proceed.
4. The Agreement includes indemnification provisions, which must be approved by the City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The City Engineer, or designee, is authorized to execute the Right of Entry Agreement substantially in accordance with the Agreement attached to the original of this Ordinance and, by reference, made of part hereof.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay in execution may interfere with construction and impact overall project completion; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
