7. BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS

Include:

-history of project - The City of Portland is one of several members in the Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI) - Portland Metropolitan Region. One of the subgroups of this organization is the Fire Working Group (FWG) which includes representatives of fire agencies throughout the region.

Portland Fire & Rescue (PF&R) is a member of the FWG and currently operates an Urban Search and Rescue (USAR) team as one of its specialty response teams.

The FWG identified the lack of a crane to quickly and safely lift or stabilize large, heavy pieces of rubble, vehicles, and other objects, during search and rescue operations following large scale disasters as a critical rescue gap in their USAR response plan. Therefore, they voted to request \$500,000 for PF&R's heavy rescue in their #1 priority package for the 2010 UASI grant request.

PF&R determined that a tractor-drawn configuration will enhance maneuverability and make responding in congested downtown or windy streets in the west hills safer and easier and will provide sufficient storage capacity to allow hydraulic and pneumatic rescue tools to be carried in a ready-to-operate manner. PF&R also determined that the tractor-drawn configuration will more effectively spread the load which improves the ability of the floor to withstand the load.

December, 2010, PF&R and Portland Bureau of Purchases conducted a nationwide search of fire apparatus manufacturers soliciting interest in working with PF&R to design and engineer a tractor-drawn heavy rescue equipped with a crane. The only manufacturer to respond was Pierce Manufacturing. Pierce Manufacturing is committed to working with PF&R to design and engineer a crane to operate as an integral component of a heavy rescue of a tractor-drawn design, incorporating PF&R's normal specifications into the apparatus.

Perhaps the singular, most important component in any PF&R apparatus is the power train. PF&R has a significant investment in the Detroit Diesel power train with respect to maintenance and repair expertise, training, and parts because virtually the entire fleet of PF&R apparatus is powered by the Detroit Diesel power train. In order to avoid serious mechanical, structural, and legal issues, PF&R requires that Detroit Diesel certify the engine installation and external support systems in the fire apparatus manufacturer's chassis. With the 2010 EPA Emissions Standards, Detroit Diesel will only certify their power train in a Pierce fire apparatus chassis.

Since the tractor-drawn heavy rescue with crane will solve numerous emergency response problems; Pierce Manufacturing is the only fire apparatus manufacturer that expressed an interest in working with PF&R on the tractor-drawn heavy rescue with crane project; and since Detroit Diesel will only certify their power train in a Pierce Manufacturing chassis, PF&R wants to enter into a sole source project with Pierce Manufacturing to engineer and manufacture a tractor-drawn heavy rescue with crane.
