7. BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS

Attached is an ordinance to increase Northwest Testing, Inc's Contract No. 36927 by \$20,057.30 for the subject project. The amendment will allow for additional materials testing & special inspection consulting services for the Fire Station 31 project to include: inspections for wood diaphragms and shearwalls, continuous concrete, field gluing, epoxy dowel installation, and fabrication shop. Additional work also includes pre-construction testing of masonry grout, mortar and CMU prisms.

RFP No. BGS014 for consultants to provide Materials Testing & Special Inspection Consulting Services as required was issued on March 10, 2006. Five firms responded and all were awarded contracts. A contract in the amount of \$50,000 was awarded to Northwest Testing, Inc. who is a state-certified MBE and ESB.

Amendment No. 1 was issued in May of 2009, extending the contract expiration date by one year, or until July 31, 2010.

Amendment No. 2 was issued in May of 2010, extending the contract expiration date by one year, or until July 31, 2011.

Four task orders (including amendments) totaling \$50,000 have been issued for various projects.

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8. FINANCIAL IMPACT

The cost of the amendment is \$20,057.30. The cost is covered in the budget for the Fire Facilities G.O. bond Fund.
