Combine to create activity code (a.k.a., WBS element)

Combine the codes identified in steps 1, 2 and 3 to create an activity code (a.k.a., WBS element). For example:

- **H10543.UCL** = Block 49 Veterans Housing Underwriting/Closing/Legal
- **H33441.CMG** = Svaboda Commons Construction Management
- H37914.POL.SP = Housing Policy & Planning Policy & Outreach South Park Blocks
- **H89010.CMG.CD** = Home Repair Projects Construction Management CDBG
- **H89020.LNO.IN** = Homebuyer Assistance Loan Origination Interstate URA
- H89030.PLN.CE = Affordable Rental Housing- Planning/Analysis/Feasibility Central Eastside URA
