ORDINANCE No. 184725

* Authorize application to the Oregon Department of Transportation, Transportation Safety Division for a grant in the amount of \$290,304 for the 2011-13 Work Zone Enforcement Program for patrol overtime (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Federal Highway Administration will provide \$3.7 million to the State of Oregon in federal funds for education, enforcement and minor equipment needs. The statewide Work Zone Enforcement Program is operated on a biennial budget authorization through the Oregon Transportation Commission;
- 2. The Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) Transportation Safety Division (TSD) makes awards to the Oregon State Police and local law enforcement agencies with the provisions of local cooperative policing agreements to patrol specified work zones on state highways;
- 3. The City of Portland, Oregon Police Bureau wishes to apply for ODOT TSD grant funding for the 2011-13 Work Zone Enforcement Program;
- 4. The Oregon Department of Transportation will reimburse the City a maximum of \$290,304 for expenses incurred for sworn personnel overtime worked on the 2011-13 Work Zone Enforcement Program;
- 5. Local match in the amount of \$56,410 will be provided by funds from FY 2011-12 and FY 2012-13 bureau program budget appropriations; and
- 6. The grant period is July 1, 2011, through June 30, 2013.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to make application to ODOT TSD for a grant in the amount of \$290,304 in a form substantially in accordance with the application attached as Exhibit A.
- b. The Mayor is authorized to provide such information and assurances as are required for the grant period.
- c. The OMF Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would unnecessarily delay the City's ability to perform the activities authorized by the grant. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
