

ORDINANCE No. 184732

*Accept and appropriate a grant in the amount of \$60,000 from Oregon Military Department, Office of Emergency Management for the FY 2010 State Homeland Security Grant for Records Digitization (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds

1. The City of Portland Office of Emergency Management in conjunction (assisted in preparation) with Multnomah County applied to Oregon Military Department, Office of Emergency Management for a grant in the amount of \$129,000 for Preparedness Planning for the FY 2010 State Homeland Security Grant April 2010; and
2. The Oregon Military Department, Office of Emergency Management notified the City of Portland that it will award a grant for the FY 2010 State Homeland Security Grant to the Bureau of Development Services for records digitization; and
3. The Oregon Office of Emergency Management will reimburse the City for a records digitization microfiche scan station expenses not to exceed the awarded amount of \$60,000; and
4. There are no financial match requirements for the State Homeland Security Program grant; and
5. The grant period is May 1, 2011 through December 31, 2012.

NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland a grant from the Oregon Military Department, Office of Emergency Management for the Records Digitization in the amount of \$60,000.
- b. The Office of Management & Finance Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.
- c. The Director of Bureau of Development Services of the City of Portland is authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland any subsequent modifications by Oregon Military Department, Office of Emergency Management for Records Digitization grant, award number 10-357, provided such modifications do not increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk. Any modifications that increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk must be authorized by the Portland City Council.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would unnecessarily delay the City's ability to perform the activities authorized by the grant. Therefore this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.


