Adopt the 2011 Alert and Warning Annex (Resolution)

WHEREAS, Incidents that threaten people, property or the environment can arise with little notice but some occur with enough warning that appropriate notification can be issued to ensure the appropriate level of preparation; and

WHEREAS, Multiple systems are needed to alert the greatest number possible of at risk populations in emergencies; and

WHEREAS, Portland Office of Emergency Management relies on the lead response bureaus, BOEC, or other emergency management partner agencies to initiate notification to POEM of an emergency event; and

WHEREAS, The provisions of the 2011 Alert and Warning Annex seek to establish and maintain consistent understanding and use of information, technology and relationships to facilitate timely and effective communication of time and mission-critical information among bureaus, emergency management partners and the general public to minimize the risk of death, injury, damage or disruption of essential services; and

WHEREAS, The 2011 Alert and Warning Annex identifies the systems the roles and responsibilities for the use of these systems.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the 2011 Alert and Warning Annex to the Basic Emergency Operations Plan is hereby adopted as a non-binding policy, substantially as set forth in Exhibit A, attached to this resolution; and
