

An ordinance to amend an ordinance
entitled "an ordinance concerning offences and
disorderly conduct," passed July 28th 1865

The city of Portland does ordain as follows

That Section 1 of ordinance numbered 228
entitled "an ordinance concerning offences and
disorderly conduct" passed July 28th 1865 be and
is hereby repealed, and the following is enacted
in place thereof;

Section 1. - That any person or persons who
shall be guilty of any violent riotous or
disorderly conduct or shall use any abusive
or obscene language in any street house
or place whereby the peace and quiet
of the city shall or may be disturbed, or
who shall be guilty of any indecent or
immoral practice, shall on conviction
thereof before the Recorder be subject to
a penalty of not less than five nor
more than one hundred dollars
