

ORDINANCE No. 184761

\* Authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement with Multnomah County for the rental of County Public Safety indoor training rooms (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Police Bureau has a need for indoor training rooms to provide training.
2. Multnomah County rents out County Public Safety indoor training rooms.
3. Renting these rooms shall not exceed \$5,000 per year to be paid from existing Police Bureau appropriations.
4. The City of Portland, Police Bureau wishes to enter into an agreement with Multnomah County effective June 1, 2011 through May 31, 2012.
5. The term of the agreement shall automatically renew year to year unless terminated sooner under the terms of the agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with Multnomah County substantially in accordance with the agreement attached as Exhibit A.

Section 2. The Council declares an emergency exists because delay in proceeding with this agreement will unnecessarily deprive the County and the City of the mutual benefits of this agreement. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
