ORDINANCE No. 184763

* Authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement with Multnomah County to fund services that provide alternatives to prostitution in an amount not to exceed \$120,000 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The City and Multnomah County are committed to addressing the problem of prostitution in East Portland.
- 2. In April 2009, the City entered into an agreement with Multnomah County providing funding through the City's portion of a grant award from the U.S. Department of Justice (USDOJ), Office of Justice Programs (OJP), Bureau of Justice Assistance (BJA) under the Recovery Act: Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Program Grant.
- 3. The City wishes to extend the compensation for the New Options for Women (NOW) program with Multnomah County through Lifeworks beyond the ARRA JAG funding.
- 4. The term of the agreement begins June 1, 2011 and continuing no later than November 20, 2011 or until the \$120,000 in funding expires.
- 5. Cost of this agreement shall not exceed \$120,000 to come from existing, ongoing General Fund appropriation to facilitate the work of the Prostitution Coordination Team.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to enter into an agreement substantially in accordance with the agreement attached as Exhibit A.

Section 2. The Council declares an emergency exists because delay in proceeding with this agreement will unnecessarily deprive the City and the County of the mutual benefits of this agreement. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
