**ORDINANCE No.**

\*Amend contract with Cornforth Consultants Inc. for additional professional engineering services for the emergency procurement related to the Landslide Mitigation Project on Sam Jackson Hill Park Road. (Ordinance; amend Contract No. 30002077)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. On May 4, 2011, the City's Director of the Bureau of Transportation requested and received from the Chief Procurement Officer authority to proceed on an emergency basis with the above project. At that time the best estimate we could provide due to the emergency nature was a total not to exceed \$75,000.
2. PBOT proceeded with a known scope of work for an initial mitigation evaluation that the consultant estimated to cost \$27,700, and Contract 30002077 was executed in that amount. That assessment has been provided and based on the results of that assessment further work has been identified as being required immediately, and additional professional engineering work along with construction management expertise will be required.
3. PBOT anticipates that the cost of the additional work associated with the engineering services may necessitate an additional \$72,300. The new NTE authorized amount would then be \$100,000.
4. The Bureau's level of confidence in the cost estimates for this project is moderate, due to the many unknown variables in the project.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. That the Chief Procurement officer is authorized to sign the amendment attached hereto in substantially the same form as the attachment, and the City Auditor is authorized to pay claims against Contract No. 30002077.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because any delay in the project will negatively impact surrounding areas and traffic flows; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.


