

ORDINANCE No. 184766

*Approve an Intergovernmental Agreement with Clark County for the distribution of equipment, supplies and services procured as a result of Urban Areas Security Initiative Grant funds.
(Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds that:

1. The City of Portland (SUBGRANTEE) has been awarded an FY 2010 Urban Areas Security Initiative (UASI) Grant #10-1070.
2. The City of Portland is the official administrator for the UASI regional grants.
3. Clark County is a stakeholder in the UASI region.
4. The FY 2010 UASI Grant award of \$6,874,736 (Ordinance #184474) is for addressing the unique planning, organization, equipment, training, and exercise needs of high-threat, high-density Urban Areas, and assist in building enhanced and sustainable regional capabilities to prevent, protect against, respond to, and recover from acts of terrorism.
5. Administration of these grants will be implemented as per the attached IGA (Exhibit A).

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor and the City Auditor are authorized to enter into the agreement between the City of Portland and Clark County as detailed in Exhibit A.
- b. The Mayor and the Auditor hereby are authorized to draw and deliver checks chargeable to the UASI FY 2010 Grant Budget, Cost Center EMEM000002, when demand is presented and approved by the proper authorities.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists so as to maximize the grant award period of performance. Therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by Council.


