7. BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS

Include:

-history of project – The National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) is an international non-profit agency established in 1896. The mission of the NFPA is to reduce fires and other hazards by creating and advocating standards for fire codes, safety codes, research, training and education. The NFPA has several committees that create standards and codes related to firefighter safety and operations. Daniel Rossos became chairperson of two of these committees during his employment with PF&R. Mr. Rossos has retired from PF&R but his chairperson duties do not expire until March 2012. Having a PF&R representative as chairperson of these prestigious committees has allowed PF&R to obtain grant funds for purchasing of newer, safer equipment, including, but not limited to improved Self-Contained Breathing Apparatus and Personal Alert Safety Systems. In addition, PF&R was made aware of a pending change in procedures regarding shipboard firefighting. That knowledge kept PF&R from investing thousands of dollars and hundreds of staff-hours on training and equipment that is in the process of becoming obsolete.
