ORDINANCE No. 184794

* Authorize grant agreement with Black Parent Initiative for In-Home Program designed to keep children safely at home and out of the child welfare system (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Black Parent Initiative (BPI) inspires and mobilizes black parents to ensure their children achieve educational excellence. BPI'S vision is actualized by inspiring, engaging, and mobilizing parents and caregivers to improve the educational outcomes of black children. BPI is currently the only culturally specific organization in Portland focused solely on supporting low-moderate income parents in Portland as a vehicle for enhancing the lives of black youth.
- 2. In the 2011/12 budget the Council allocated \$100,000.00 to BPI for its "In-Home Program" which is designed to keep children safely at home and out of the child welfare system.
- 3. Funds are available for this grant and were appropriated in the FY 2011-12 Adopted Budget as a Special Appropriation (SA 16).

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Commissioner of Public Affairs is authorized to enter into an Agreement with the Miracles Club as substantially set forth in Exhibit A attached to this ordinance.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to FY 2011-12 Adopted Budget Special Appropriation SA_16, in an amount not to exceed \$100,000 once the grant agreement is executed.

Section 2. The council declares that an emergency exists because a delay in authorizing this portion of the grant funds could cause BPI a delay in delivering services; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
