## ORDINANCE No. 184795

Authorize a contract and provide for payment for the construction of the Washington Park Sewer Rehabilitation Project No. E10103 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

## Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Approximately 1,700 feet of combined sewer main in the Washington Park between SW Sherwood Blvd and W Burnside St will be repaired using Cured-In-Place-Pipe (CIPP), pipe bursting, and open cut excavation.
- 2. Environmental Services has prepared plans and specifications for rehabilitating the sewers manholes, service laterals, and inlets.
- 3. Environmental Services requires the furnishing of materials and labor for this project.
- 4. The estimated cost is \$520,000. The level of confidence in this estimate is high. Funds are available in the Bureau of Environmental Services Sewer System Operating Fund, FY 2011-2012, Project No. E10103.

## NOW, THEREFORE, the council directs:

- a. The Commissioner of Public Affairs is authorized to execute a contract with the lowest responsible bidder for the purpose described in Section 1, in the amount of \$ 520,000.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.
