ORDINANCE NO.184799

Amend Intergovernmental Agreement with Multnomah County Department of Community Justice to hire at-risk youth for maintenance of Water Bureau grounds (Ordinance; amend Contract No. 37038)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Ordinance No. 180534 passed Council on October 18, 2006 authorizing an Intergovernmental Agreement with Multnomah County Department of Community Justice to hire at-risk youth for outdoor maintenance and landscape.
- 2. The program has successfully provided on-the-job training including developing good work habits while providing continuing maintenance of Water Bureau grounds sites to at-risk youth throughout the community.
- 3. The Water Bureau has worked with the Multnomah County Department of Community Justice's Project Payback program successfully for many years. The current agreement expired on June 30, 2011.
- 4. The Water Bureau and Multnomah County desire to extend the existing Intergovernmental Agreement for an additional 5 years.
- 5. Amendment shall provide an allowance under this Intergovernmental Agreement of \$75,000 per Fiscal Year. Funding shall be requested in the FY 2011-12 Fall BuMP and will be requested in FY 2012-13 through FY 2015-16.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. That the Commissioner-in-Charge and Auditor are authorized to execute on behalf of the City an amendment to Intergovernmental Agreement No. 37038, with Multnomah County Department of Community Justice as outlined in a form substantially in accordance with the amendment attached as Exhibit A.
- b. That the Portland Water Bureau Administrator is authorized to execute and amend on behalf of the City the Intergovernmental Agreement similar to the form attached as Exhibit A, with such changes deemed by the Administrator to be appropriate in individual circumstances as approved by the City Attorney's Office. Any increase exceeding twenty-five percent of the total compensation would need City Council approval.

c. All other terms and provisions of Intergovernmental Agreement No. 37038, remain the same and are not affected by this amendment.
