Amendment 1 to INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT No. 37038 To Hire At Risk Youth

Pursuant to Ordinance No. 180534

This Intergovernmental Agreement was made and entered by and between the Multnomah County Dept. of Community Justice, hereinafter called County, and the City of Portland, a municipal corporation of the State of Oregon, by and through its duly authorized representatives, hereinafter called City.

- 1. This Intergovernmental Agreement is hereby extended through June 30, 2016.
- 2. There will be no additional changes to the fiscal year allowance under this Intergovernmental Agreement which allows for \$75,000.
- 3. The City of Portland Water Bureau intends to request funds for the agreement from Fiscal Year 2011-12 through Fiscal Year 2012-16.
- 4. The funding provided by this Intergovernmental Agreement is contingent upon the continued availability of funding. If funds become unavailable through lack of appropriations, budget cuts, transfer of funds, or any other disruptions of current appropriated funding for this Intergovernmental Agreement, the City may restrict, reduce, or terminate funding under this Intergovernmental Agreement.
- 5. All other terms and conditions shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect.

This amendment to the Intergovernmental Agreement may be signed in two (2) or more counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original, and which, when taken together, shall constitute one and the same amendment to the Intergovernmental Agreement.
