

ORDINANCE No. 184810

* Accept a grant in the amount of \$290,304 and appropriate \$145,152 for FY 2011-12 from the Oregon Department of Transportation, Transportation Safety Division 2011-13 Work Zone Enforcement Program for sworn personnel overtime (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Police Bureau applied to the Oregon Department of Transportation, Transportation Safety Division for the 2011-13 Work Zone Enforcement Program grant on July 13, 2011; and
2. The Oregon Department of Transportation, Transportation Safety Division has notified the City of Portland that it will award a grant for the 2011-13 Work Zone Enforcement Program to the Police Bureau in the amount of \$290,304; and
3. The Oregon Department of Transportation will reimburse the City a maximum of \$290,304 for payroll expenses incurred by the Police Bureau for Traffic Division; and
4. Local match in the amount of \$56,410 will be provided by funds from FY 2011-12 and FY 2012-13 bureau program budget appropriations; and
5. The grant period is July 1, 2011, through June 30, 2013.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland a grant from the Oregon Department of Transportation for the 2011-13 Work Zone Enforcement Program in the amount of \$290,304.
- b. The FY 2011-2012 budget is hereby amended as follows:
GRANTS FUND
Fund - 217
Business Area - PL00
Bureau Program Expenses - \$145,152
- c. The Office of Management & Finance Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.

- d. The Chief of the Police Bureau of the City of Portland is authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland any subsequent modifications by the Oregon Department of Transportation for the 2011-13 Work Zone Enforcement Program, 1113WKZN-421 GGG, provided such modifications do not increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk. Any modifications that increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk must be authorized by the Portland City Council.


