### 7. BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS

The City and the Portland Police Association (Union) completed negotiations and ratification of the July 1, 2010 through June 30, 2013 Labor Agreement on March 3, 2011. The Parties have outstanding issues that were unresolved during those negotiations. The Parties agree it is in their best interests to resolve these issues by amending the Labor Agreement.

Additionally, the Parties have a grievance settlement agreement that requires Councils authorization for payment.

### 8. FINANCIAL IMPACT

There is no anticipated increase in cost to the City. The Memorandum of Agreement and Settlement Agreement codify an existing practice regarding holiday compensation and on-call pay premium. There is, however, and anticipated one-time cost of \$7,795.20 for the grievance settlement payment and a one-time cost of \$56,911.84 for compensation of PPA members for on-call telephone calls from June 4, 2009 to present.
