7. <u>BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS</u>

The Bureau of Human Resources (BHR) requested the creation of a new classification of Training and Development Manager. A current position will be reclassified to staff this function within BHR with a goal of developing a comprehensive and inclusive city-wide training and education program for the City of Portland's workforce. The BHR Classification and Compensation Unit also reviewed the compensation level of the proposed classification, and is recommending a Nonrepresented salary range 11. This is an emergency ordinance so that a recruitment effort can begin without delay.

8. FINANCIAL IMPACT

There is no increased cost in salary and benefits for this classification action. However, when the current position is reclassified, the new classification will be at a higher salary level. Currently the annual maximum rate for the position is \$84, 635. The classification approved by this ordinance will have a maximum rate of \$100,048, an annual increase of \$15,413.
