## ORDINANCE No. 184874

\* Authorize application to the Oregon Association Chiefs of Police for a grant in the amount of \$74,000 for the 2012 Safety Belt Enforcement Program for sworn personnel overtime (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Oregon Association Chiefs of Police (OACP) makes awards to Oregon law enforcement agencies for the Safety Belt Enforcement Program. The objective of the program is to increase compliance with Oregon's occupant restraint laws towards the State's goal of reducing traffic crash fatality and injury rates; and
- 2. The City of Portland, Oregon Police Bureau wishes to apply for OACP grant funding. Traffic Division sworn personnel will provide direct enforcement and educational training; and
- 3. The OACP will reimburse the City a maximum of \$74,000 for expenses incurred by the bureau for Traffic Division sworn personnel overtime hours worked on the 2012 Safety Belt program. The reimbursement rate is \$40.00 per hour; and
- 4. This grant requires a local match of two hours straight-time enforcement for every one hour of overtime worked enforcing occupant restraint laws. Local match in the amount of \$139,490 shall be provided by funds from City of Portland matching funds in the form of personnel expenses in the FY 2011-12 and FY 2012-13 budgets of the Police Bureau. The City will also incur payroll expenses for the hourly overtime rates above the grant's \$40.00 per hour limit and all benefit expenses related to grant overtime in the form of personnel expenses in the FY 2011-12 and FY 2012-13 budgets of the Police Bureau; and
- 5. The grant period is October 1, 2011, through September 30, 2012.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to make application to OACP for a grant in the amount of \$74,000 in a form substantially in accordance with the application attached as Exhibit A.
- b. The Mayor is authorized to provide such information and assurances as are required for the grant period.
- c. The OMF Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay in proceeding with this application may result in not receiving funding. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
