ORDINANCE No. 184885

Amend Property Maintenance Regulations Code to reflect changes to curbside collection services (Ordinance; amend Code Section 29.30.140)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Council has adopted regulations addressing minimum standards for property maintenance cleanliness and sanitation. Portland City Code Title 29. The City Code provides that it is a nuisance condition to allow the accumulation of garbage and trash. Section 29.20.010.H. The City Code separately requires owners of residential rental property and owners of owner-occupied properties that have been posted two or more times within one year for violations of Section 29.20.010 H to subscribe to and pay for weekly garbage collection. Section 29.30.140.
- On August 8, 2007, the Council passed Resolution No. 36525 which called for the adoption
 of the residential and city operations portions of the Portland Recycles! Plan. On April 30,
 2008, the Council passed Resolution No. 36601 to adopt the commercial portion of the Plan.
 Both resolutions directed the Office of Sustainable Development to prepare and submit to
 Council amendments to the Portland City Code to implement the Plan.
- 3. The Council recently adopted new rates for solid waste, recycling and composting collection. Ordinance No. 184821, adopted August 17, 2011. This rate schedule includes weekly collection of yard debris and food scraps and eliminates weekly garbage collection. Garbage collection will occur on an every-other-week schedule.
- 4. Section 29.30.140 Cleanliness and Sanitation should be amended to conform to the recent changes in collection cycles, to assure collection of materials from rental properties as well as owners posted two or more times for violation of Section 29.20.010.H (1) or (2).

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. Title 29 of the City Code, Property Maintenance Regulations, is hereby amended as set forth in Exhibit A attached to this ordinance.
