

ORDINANCE No.

Authorize a contract with the lowest responsible bidder for the Guilds Lake Pump Station Improvements, Project No. E08877 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Bureau of Environmental Services (BES) has a need to remodel the existing Guilds Lake Pump Station. Remodel is necessary due to equipment condition and age; to address safety, reliability, and maintenance access issues; and to comply with current regulatory requirements.
2. The remodel of the Guilds Lake Pump Station has been identified as a priority project within the BES Pump Station Improvement Program.
3. The estimated cost is \$2,600,000. Confidence in cost estimate is Optimal. Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY2011-2012 Budget, Bureau of Environmental Services, Project Number E08877.

NOW, THEREFORE, the council directs:

- a. The Commissioner of Public Affairs is authorized to execute a contract with the lowest responsible bidder for the purpose described in Section 1, in the amount of \$2,600,000.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.
