- WHEREAS, the City of Portland has an interest in being able to appeal arbitration awards or rulings when arbitrators have exceeded their legal authority in making such awards or rulings;
- WHEREAS, in Dep't. of Human Servs. et al. v. AFSCME Local 3295, the State of Oregon Employment Relations Board concluded that it generally could not review whether an arbitrator exceeded his or her legal authority in making an award;
- the Oregon Court of Appeals affirmed the decision of the Employment WHEREAS, Relations Board in that case without opinion:
- WHEREAS, the Oregon Department of Justice is seeking review of that decision in the Oregon Supreme Court:
- the decisions of the Employment Relations Board and Court of Appeals, if WHEREAS, not reversed by the Oregon Supreme Court, may preclude any future attempts by the City of Portland to appeal arbitration awards or rulings when arbitrators exceed their legal authority;
- an appearance by the City of Portland as amicus curiae may persuade the WHEREAS, Oregon Supreme Court to review and reverse the decisions of the Employment Relations Board and Court of Appeals;
- WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the City of Portland to participate in this court proceeding;
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Attorney or her designee is authorized to participate as amicus curiae in the Oregon Supreme Court, in State of Oregon et al. v. AFSCME Local 3295, on behalf of the City of Portland.
