*Authorize a contract to purchase three hybrid vehicles for \$77,400 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The CityFleet Division of the Bureau of Internal Business Services recognizes the need for three additional vehicles due to three new employees in Development Services.
- 2. It has been determined that three hybrid vehicles need to be purchased for Development Services vehicles #N12003, #N12004, #N12005, Exhibit A attached.
- 3. The estimated cost of these vehicles is \$25,800 each, or \$77,400 for all three hybrid vehicles.
- 4. The City now desires to purchase these vehicles.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to issue a purchase order for three hybrid vehicles, Exhibit A, in accordance with City Code 5.33.
- b. The Mayor and City Auditor are hereby authorized to pay for said purchases from the CityFleet replacement funds.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because delay in proceeding with the purchases would result in additional expense and unnecessarily deprive the City of the use of these vehicles at an early date; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
