ORDINANCE No. 184910

*Authorize a contract to replace seven Aerial trucks for \$1,603,000 (Ordinance)

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The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The CityFleet Division of the Bureau of Internal Business Services replaces all City vehicles based on an annual replacement plan.
- 2. CityFleet has reviewed the standard replacement schedule and the condition of the Transportation Maintenance Aerial trucks.
- 3. It has been determined that seven Aerial trucks need to be replaced for Transportation Maintenance vehicles #004900, #004901, #004902, #004903, #004904, #004905 and #004906, Exhibit A attached.
- 4. The estimated cost of these vehicles is \$229,000 each, or \$1,603,000 for all seven aerial trucks.
- 5. The City now desires to purchase these vehicles.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to issue a purchase order for seven Aerial trucks, Exhibit A, in accordance with City Code 5.33.
- b. The Mayor and City Auditor are hereby authorized to pay for said purchases from the CityFleet replacement funds.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because delay in proceeding with the purchases would result in additional expense and unnecessarily deprive the City of the use of these vehicles at an early date; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
