

ORDINANCE No. 184911

Authorize a contract with Federal Engineering, Inc. for Voice Radio System Specifications Development for a total not-to-exceed amount of \$160,482. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The City of Portland's (City) Public Safety Systems Revitalization Program (PSSRP) was established to manage and coordinate the replacement and upgrade of the City's Public Safety Systems including the voice radio system.
2. The City requires expert assistance with inventory analysis, recommendations regarding an upgrade or replacement of the existing voice radio system, and assistance with the City's procurement of the system's upgrade or replacement.
3. The services were advertised under Request for Proposals (RFP) No. 113066 and 7 responsive Proposals were received. The selection committee reviewed and scored these proposals in accordance with PCC 5.68 and selected Federal Engineering, Inc.
4. The City desires to enter into a Professional, Technical & Expert (PTE) contract with Federal Engineering, Inc., with a not-to-exceed contract amount of \$160,482.00.
5. There is no M/W/ESB participation in this contract.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council Directs:


