*Authorize an Interconnection and Net Metering Service Agreement with Pacific Power for a solar electricity generation system at Dishman Community Center. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. Portland's Climate Action Plan 2009 (adopted by Resolution No. 36748), establishes a goal of purchasing 100 percent of the electricity required for City operations from renewable sources with at least 15 percent from onsite or district renewable energy sources such as solar and biogas.
2. Solar electric systems on City of Portland facilities presents a promising opportunity to advance key environmental goals, support local businesses and manufacturers, and reduce electricity bills at City-owned facilities, such as community centers.
3. An Interconnection and Net Metering Service Agreement with Pacific Power is required to connect the solar system with the local electric utility's distribution system. Under a Net Metering Service Agreement, all of the power generated by the solar facility over the course of a year will be applied towards the electricity needs of Dishman Community Center, offsetting electricity purchases from the utility.
4. Under the U.S. Department of Energy's Energy Efficiency Conservation Block Grant program, the Bureau of Planning and Sustainability and Portland Parks & Recreation were awarded \$280,000 to install a 51-kilowatt solar electric system at Dishman Community Center (Ordinance No. 183441). When completed, the solar system will generate approximately 45,000 kilowatt-hours of electricity each year.

NOW, THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The Director of Portland Parks & Recreation, or their designee, is authorized to sign an Interconnection and Net Metering Service Agreement, substantially similar to the document attached, with Pacific Power for a solar electricity generation system at Dishman Community Center.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because of the deadline for submission of this Interconnection and Net Metering Agreement; therefore this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
