**<u>1) Legislation Title:</u>** Adopt the recommendations of the Final Report of the public-private Work Group to Study Containers in the Right-of-Way, and direct City Bureaus to implement the Recommendations (Resolution)

**<u>2)</u>** Purpose of the Proposed Legislation: Instructs the Office of Sustainable Development, and the Bureau of Development Services to prepare an ordinance requiring that all new buildings and buildings requiring seismic alterations shall provide space on their property sufficient to store the garbage and recycling generated by their use, and new language prohibiting ongoing storage of garbage and recycling containers in the right of way to become effective six months after the passage of this resolution
