ORDINANCE No. 184966

* Authorize a competitive solicitation for the construction of two 50' aluminum hull fireboats (Ordinance)

The City of Portland finds:

- 1. Portland Fire & Rescue (PF&R) requires replacement of two of its fireboats as they reach the end of their useful life over the next five years.
- 2. The Specifications and Outboard Profile and General Arrangements were created by Jensen Maritime Consultants, authorized through Professional, Technical and Expert Services Outline Agreement 30002110.
- 3. The estimated replacement costs for these two fireboats is \$2,000,000 each, for a total of approximately \$4,000,000.
- 4. General Obligation Bond funds authorized by the citizens of Portland in the November 2010 election will be used to pay for the purchase of the two fireboats.
- 5. PF&R seeks the Council authorization for Procurement Services to issue a Request for Proposal (RFP) resulting in a not-to-exceed contract.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to facilitate the use of the competitive solicitation process in order to obtain the most responsible and responsive Offeror providing a not-to-exceed contract for the construction of two 50' aluminum hull fireboats.
- b. Upon Council acceptance of the Chief Procurement Officer's Report, Procurement Services is authorized to negotiate and execute a contract, provided the contract has been approved as to form by the City Attorney's office.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay in proceeding with the purchase will unnecessarily put the City at risk from continued operations of the two existing fireboats beyond the end of their service life; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
