

ORDINANCE No.

\* Authorize a competitive solicitation for the construction of two 50' aluminum hull fireboats (Ordinance)

The City of Portland finds:

1. Portland Fire & Rescue (PF&R) requires replacement of two of its fireboats as they reach the end of their useful life over the next five years.
2. The Specifications and Outboard Profile and General Arrangements were created by Jensen Maritime Consultants, authorized through Professional, Technical and Expert Services Outline Agreement 30002110.
3. The estimated replacement costs for these two fireboats is \$2,000,000 each, for a total of approximately \$4,000,000.
4. General Obligation Bond funds authorized by the citizens of Portland in the November 2010 election will be used to pay for the purchase of the two fireboats.
5. PF&R seeks the Council authorization for Procurement Services to issue a Request for Proposal (RFP) resulting in a not-to-exceed contract.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to facilitate the use of the competitive solicitation process in order to obtain the most responsible and responsive Offeror providing a not-to-exceed contract for the construction of two 50' aluminum hull fireboats.
- b. Upon Council acceptance of the Chief Procurement Officer's Report, Procurement Services is authorized to negotiate and execute a contract, provided the contract has been approved as to form by the City Attorney's office.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay in proceeding with the purchase will unnecessarily put the City at risk from continued operations of the two existing fireboats beyond the end of their service life; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
